Sewing and Notions

Fleece Blankets (*We will cut and tie these at the conference*)

1) Heart of the World (1 ½ yard)

Fleece for blankets (polar or anti-pill) should be patterned. (*NONE of the following: Commercial patterns. Sports Teams, Animation Characters, Camouflage, Disney, Rainbows, or Signs.*)

2) Little Lambs Fleece (1 ½ yard Children, 1 yard Baby) Any pattern is fine

Flannel Projects (1 ½ yds. of 100% cotton flannel) or (Any remnants you may want to donate)

1) *Days for Girls: Soft, heavier weight flannel that is printed on both sides, a solid or a print that will hide stains, avoid light colors that will show stains, avoid juvenile or baby prints. (NO Felt)*

2) Flannel Receiving Blankets (1 yd., single thickness) Light colors and juvenile, baby prints are fine.
