You are cordially invited to participate in the **2019 Hyde Park City Royalty Pageant**. Girls who live in Hyde Park and are now completing their junior year of high school are eligible. This is a wonderful opportunity to represent your community, make new friends, increase your talents, and have a lot of fun!

The Pageant has been scheduled for **Thursday March 7, 2019 at the Hyde Park City building**. That afternoon the interviews will be conducted and that evening the pageant and final selection of the 2019 Royalty will take place.

Included with this letter is an Application Packet and information about the Pageant process.

- **Application packets are due at the Hyde Park City office on Monday, February 25th by 5:00 p.m. Late applications will not be accepted.**
- Your Application packet must include pages 1-3, completely filled out (Application, Parent Permission Form, Applicant Information) and a headshot photo of you, (any size).

Hyde Park City Royalty members are expected to represent the City well at all times. There are also specific times when they are formally representing the City, such as when they ride the City float in parades throughout the Valley. These parades occur during the spring, summer and fall. The most important of which is our own Hyde Park City Celebration in July. **Royalty members are expected to be present for the City Celebration and for a majority of the parades and other activities.** The Royalty helps clean and prepare the float for the parade season. They also help at various other City events, including the Easter Egg Hunt, Memorial Day breakfast, Hyde Park City celebration activities, and the Christmas Tree Lighting ceremony. The City provides the funding for the dresses, tiaras, and sashes and T-shirts the Royalty wears.

Your parents' support and involvement is very important. Parents of Royalty members take turns driving the truck that pulls the float in the parades, help with care and maintenance of the float, and plan and carry out the Royalty Pageant the following year.

We look forward to receiving your Application and seeing you at the Pageant!

This is the last day to turn in your Application at the Hyde Park City Office.
Deadline is 5:00 p.m. No late Applications will be accepted.

Your application must include pages 1–3 of this packet completely filled out, as well as a headshot photo of you (any size). If you wish, you may reproduce pages 2 and 3 on your computer and list your answers below the questions, as long as the formatting (2 pages of information) and word limits are still followed.

Thursday, March 7, 2019

Each participant will have an individual interview with the Judges at the Hyde Park City Building. This will be by appointment and will last 10–15 minutes. Anticipated appointment times are between 3:30–6:30 pm. You will be contacted by phone and/or email to let you know your appointment time.

~ Please arrive 10 minutes before your appointment time.

~ Wear Sunday or Business/Professional dress

~ Bring a framed 8x10 portrait of yourself to this interview. This portrait will be part of the Pageant decorations in the evening, and you will take it home following the Pageant. This picture is in addition to the one you will submit with your Application.

Depending on your interview time, you may go home to prepare for the evening, or you may need to come to your interview prepared with your evening dress to change into after your interview.

All participants must be present at the Hyde Park City Building at 6:30 pm for preparation and instructions. The dress for participants is Formal.

The Pageant will start at 7:00 pm. Family and friends are invited to attend. Dress is casual for them.

The 2018 Royalty will be assisting at the pageant. They will also be honored for their service, after which a 2019 Queen and Attendants will be chosen. They will begin their term of service immediately.

You will be judged as you:

~ Walk a short course in front of the audience and judges as you are introduced

~ Sit and listen to the program

~ Answer a question that requires a spontaneous answer

Judging Criteria:

You will be judged on Poise, Personality, Appearance, Communication Skills, Ability to Represent the City, Portfolio (Application), Interview and Walk

Advice:

Smile!

Be on time.

Look interviewers in the eye.

Be yourself, but be your best self!

Use good posture as you sit, stand and walk.

Be confident and enthusiastic, but not overbearing.

Practice speaking without using filler words. ("like", "umm", and "uh")

Answer questions thoughtfully and sincerely. Be honest. Be positive.

Don't fidget. Keep your hands in your lap when sitting, or at your sides when standing.

Know that you are beautiful and amazing, regardless of whether you are chosen as a Royalty member!
